Criteria.

1. *A nominee must be in good standing with the Paso Fino Horse Association and must have been inactive in PFHA sanctioned events for a period of five years or must be age 60 or older as of September 1, 2012.*
2. *If deceased, the nominee must have been in good standing at the time of death.*
3. *Nominee must have invested a minimum of five years, regionally or nationally, in helping to promote the Paso Fino Breed. (e.g., National and/or Regional Officer, Delegate, Trainer, Exhibitor, or Committee Chair)*
4. *Biography must accompany nomination that lists accomplishments and contributions to the breed.*

Criteria.

1. *The horse must be registered with the Paso Fino Horse Association, Inc. and have been inactive in PFHA shows and breeding activities for a period of five years; inactive in competitive trail riding for two years; or must be age 20 or older as of September 1, 2012.*
2. *The horse and recorded owner(s) must be in good standing with the Paso Fino Horse Association, Inc. and if deceased must have been in good standing at the time of death.*
3. *A horse must meet at least one of the following criteria:*
 - a. *Must have produced eligible show offspring.*
 - b. *Demonstrated outstanding prowess in the show ring or in competitive trail competition.*
4. *The horse must have influenced the breed in a positive manner.*
5. *Biography must accompany nomination documenting the accomplishments and contributions to the breed.*
